

### **Appendix A - Insurance Information**

Contractor is required to provide Primary Engineering and Construction Corp. with a certificate of insurance, prior to performing any services, certifying that coverage required by this contract is in force and the insurer will endeavor to provide 30 days' notice of cancellation or material change. Coverage requirements are as follows:

(a) Commercial General liability insurance for bodily injury (including death) and property damage in an amount of not less than five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) inclusive limit for any one occurrence and such insurance policy shall include:

- (i) Primary Engineering and Construction Corp. as additional insured;
- (ii) Cross liability and severability of interests' clause(s);
- (iii) Products and completed operations coverage;
- (iv) Broad form contractual liability coverage;
- (v) Employer's liability coverage in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence;
- (vi) Non-owned automobile liability coverage;
- (vii) Operation of attached machinery coverage;
- (viii) a provision that the rights of Primary Engineering and Construction Corp. under any provision of the said policy shall not be prejudiced by any default or violation by the Contractor or by any other person insured by that policy;
- (ix) Waiver by the insurer of any rights of subrogation against Primary Engineering and Construction Corp.;
- (x) Sudden and accidental pollution coverage in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 per occurrence; and
- (xi) Explosion, Collapse and Underground Property damage coverage

(b) Contractors Equipment insurance covering all the replacement of any equipment owned, leased or in the care custody and control of the contractor.

(c) Automobile liability insurance for bodily injury (including death) and property damage in an amount of not less than five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) inclusive limit for any one occurrence.



(d) If the services include any professional services, Professional liability (Errors & Omissions) insurance with a limit of \$2,000,000 for each claim and in aggregate, covering losses arising or resulting from the performance or failure to perform professional services.

(e) Contractor is responsible to pay any deductible associated with any insurance claim.
